Moors of Northern Africa POPULATION 3 Million

The Moors are descendants of the Berbers in Northern Africa. Arabs drove them towards the Sahara Desert, where the now

reside in Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, and Niger. These nomadic people live as traders, merchants, shepherds, and farmers. Some Moors have relocated to the cities in search of a better life. Their cuisine, music, and art represent a fusion of past colonizers, the Arabs and the French. Many Moors practice folk Islam, which is traditional Sunni Islam combined with animistic practices. Very few follow Jesus, even though the Bible is available in their language of Hassaniya Arabic.
