Suruwaha of Brazil

Population: 150-200

The Suruwahá [soo-roo-wah-HAH] are an Indigenous group in the Amazon jungle of Brazil. They are difficult to access due to their remote location and government restrictions that prevent Indigenous peoples from changing their cultural identity. The Suruwahá live along rivers and creeks, where they farm bananas, manioc, and sugarcane. For large portions of the year, they live in a common hut, ruled by the man who built the hut. **Only 150-200 Suruwahá remain, so time is of the essence to reach them with the gospel.**

Let's pray Isaiah 45:23 | By myself I have sworn; from my mouth has gone out in righteousness a word that shall not return: "To me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear allegiance."
